The May 12, 2020, Maiden Town Council Meeting will be held electronically and streamed on Facebook. Special accommodations will be made for public comments.

In order to maintain the safety of the Town of Maiden's Citizens, Town Staff, and the Town Council, minimize exposure to Covid-19, comply with the the Executive Orders of the State of North Carolina for social distancing, stay at home mandates, and limits on gatherings and the State of Emergency declared by the Mayor of the Town of Maiden, the regular meeting of the Maiden Town Council scheduled for 6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 12, 2020, will be conducted electronically as permitted by North Carolina General Statute 143-318.13. The meetings agenda is set forth on the Town of Maiden website.

The Town is making every effort to ensure that the public is not only able to view or listen to the meeting but also participate in the public comment portion of the meeting while remaining safe and complying with statutory requirements and the various Gubernatorial Orders. The Town Council Members will participate electronically and will not physically attend the meeting. The Meeting will be streamed live via Facebook for viewing and may be accessed on the Town of Maiden Facebook Page or by following the link on the Town of Maiden website, at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday May 12, 2020. There is no cost to view the meeting through Facebook. To avoid disruptions and the posting of inappropriate content, the ability to post on the page will be suspended while the meeting is streaming. Members of the public may also listen to and view the electronic meeting at 6:00 p.m. Tuesday, May 12, 2020, by way of a computer set up at the Community Room at Maiden Town Hall, 19 North Main Ave, Maiden, NC 28650, pursuant to NCGS 143-318.3. ATTENDANCE WILL HOWEVER BE LIMITED TO TEN (10) PEOPLE in the room including one (1) staff member, pursuant to the Governor's Executive Order No.117 as amended by Executive Order 121.

Citizens who would like to participate in the meeting by making public comments, may do so in any of the following ways:

1. Members of the public may make oral comments during the public comment period or during a public hearing via telephone or electronic device supplied by the Town and located in the Community Room at MaidenTown Hall at the date and time indicated above.
2. By written comments mailed, emailed, or personally delivered to the Maiden Town Clerk no later than one (1) hour prior to the noticed time of the meeting.
