

School Crossing Guard

The school crossing guard performs the duty of assisting and protecting school children as they cross the street either as a pedestrian or by bicycle at key locations through the direction and control of pedestrians and related vehicular traffic. The position of school crossing guard is a part-time position with the Town of Maiden, working from 7-7:30 AM and 2:20-2:50 PM.

Duties and Responsibilities

1. Controls vehicular traffic at assigned crossing to allow school children to cross roadway in safety.
2. Controls children using the assigned crossing location.
3. Observe and report incidents, or conditions that present a potential safety hazard to either the school children or the guard. Report flagrant traffic violations to the on-duty patrol shift supervisor.
4. Observe and report unsafe driver behaviors, unsafe pedestrian behaviors, unlawful parking construction interfering with safe crossing, unsafe street conditions, damaged signs, poor visibility, suspicious activity, improper or lack of safety belt or bicycle helmet use.

Required Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

Working knowledge of traffic regulations and traffic control.

Ability to judge gaps in traffic to help students cross safely.

Ability to create a gap where none exists, by stepping into the street at the appropriate time and stopping traffic with hand signals and STOP paddle.

Acts as role model in helping children develop the skills necessary to cross streets safely at all times.

Ability and willingness to work in inclement weather.

Willingness to work with, and have empathy for children.

Ability to follow oral and written instructions.

Ability to deal courteously and tactfully with the public.
